Partnering with [RecycleIT](#) UK to collect all redundant IT equipment from our customers with the goal of refurbishing, reusing, and recycling every piece of equipment that schools no longer need.

Encouraging schools to make the most of the edtech they already have by adopting a reuse model. We provide schools with the option of converting low-specification devices into Chromebooks, which require fewer resources and extend the life of the device.

Promoting leasing of equipment as a leasing company is obligated to properly dispose of and recycle equipment at the end of the term in line with environmental laws and regulations.

Implementing a comprehensive take-back and recycling program for all of the company's products, by offering incentives for customers to return old or unwanted equipment, and providing clear and easy-to-understand instructions for properly disposing of equipment at the end of its life.
