

Although we do not currently have ISO 24000 – here is our approach to Sustainable Procurement

- Conduct a sustainability assessment of current suppliers and products to identify areas for improvement.
- Develop a set of criteria for evaluating potential suppliers based on their sustainability practices, such as use of renewable energy, recycling and waste reduction policies, and adherence to labor laws.
- Incorporate these criteria into the procurement process, including in the Request for Proposal (RFP) and supplier evaluation stages.
- Establish regular communication with suppliers to monitor their sustainability performance and encourage continuous improvement.
- Identify and invest in sustainable products and services, such as those made from recycled materials or utilizing digital delivery methods to reduce packaging and shipping.
- Implement internal policies and procedures to ensure sustainable procurement practices are followed throughout the organization.
- Continuously monitor and measure the impact of sustainable procurement practices, and set goals for improvement.
- Work towards obtaining certification under ISO 24000, an international standard for environmental management, to demonstrate the company's commitment to sustainable procurement.
